He enabled me to get work only after a few days of being in the country, and I am still working there in the afternoon and evening as a fulltime English Teacher while learning Mandarin Chinese in the morning. God has also provided a place for us to live that is secure and comfortable for a family of three. We live only a block away from public transportation that can take us pretty much anywhere in Kaohsiung, and a bicycle was given to me recently so I have no problem going from home to language school, to work, and then back home again. Kelly and Timothy really enjoy going to church where Kelly can fellowship with other ladies, and Timothy is pretty popular with just about everybody.

**Prayer requests:** Please pray for me to make wise decisions while I'm here, and please continue to pray for the Lord's direction for us. Please pray for Kelly and Timothy as I am not home for over 12 hours every week day. Also, please pray for Kelly's family and for their need of salvation. There is a tremendous need for Taiwanese people to hear the Gospel and it is evident by their bondage to sin. There is also a revival of Buddhist activity among young people, and it really is spiritual warfare, so please pray for us as we have opportunities to witness.
